KIDS FIRST INSTRUCTIONS

KIDS FIRST is a program designed to help parents understand the effects of separation on their children and to help children cope with changes in the families. BOTH parents **must attend**. Children (age 6-17) of Petitioner or Respondent, from this and any other relationship who have lived with the Petitioner's and Respondent's current family **must attend** Kids First unless excused by the Judge.

Failure to attend may cause you to be brought before the Court to explain your non-attendance and may be considered as a factor in custody decisions. Non-attendance may also delay the granting of your Paternity Judgment.

PARENTS' AND KIDS' CLASSES

The Parents' and Kids classes are held VIA Zoom on the last Friday of the month. The time of the class is from 4:30 pm- 6:00 pm.

You and your children will watch a video in your classrooms. Parents will have their own program presented by psychologists who specialize in paternity. The children and teens will be grouped by age and led by trained facilitators. They will play games, role play, and may express their feelings about the paternity case.

Please keep in mind that this is a one-time class.

Judicial staff will contact you prior to your class to provide you with the Zoom link and login instructions and to confirm how many devices you will need for the child classes
