Pursuant to HRS § 103D -306 and HAR Chapter 3-122, Subchapter 9, The Judiciary requests sole source approval to purchase the following:

1. Describe the goods, services or construction to be procured: UPS Replacements for 2 units, at the Juvenile Detention Facility (JDF), includes manufacturer commissioning onsite. ACS Miscellaneous Cabling and UPS Tie-in; Disposal and Misc Mounting Hardware

6. Describe in detail the following: a. The unique features, characteristics, or capabilities of the goods, service or construction. The uninterruptible power supply (UPS) protects sensitive electronics during any power outages or any electrical disruptions. The UPS in the JDF communications closet provides stored electricity to keep the Security Resources Pacific Security Systems programs operating during power outages, electrical disruptions like voltage drops and power surges. These programs include security cameras, badge readers and communications systems. Security Resources Pacific, Inc. has achieved authorization as a Network Harbor Enterprise level System Integrator and, as of this date, they are the only system integrator that has achieved Enterprise Level authorization in the state of Hawaii. The process of authorized account registration with authorized integrators is to provide both the end users and system integrators with account protection and assurance. This assurance is maintained as long as a) the system integrator maintains authorized status as a Network Harbor Dealer, and b) the end user/customer has not requested severance from their registered system integrator, and c) the end user has an active ASA support agreement as registered with the end user account. Security Resources has met all of the above criteria. b. How the unique features, characteristics or capabilities of the goods, service or construction are essential for the department. The UPS battery back up is important as it provides a seamless transition in powering up JDF's security systems during a power outage or any electrical disruptions. The UPS system is activated until the onsite generator is operating, ensuring the security system is working continuously and effectively. The security system's security cameras, badge readers and cellblock communications system will continue to operate during an electrical disruption. This UPS will provide power to the workstation that monitors cameras and controls the doors at the rear of the facility. The current UPS battery backup in the JDF communications closet is 15 years old and has been in service since JDF opened. The current UPS battery back up could fail to work at any moment due to age and inability to operate with advancing/updated security system. Within the last year, several service calls were made due to issues with the security system as a direct result of the UPS not powering up and activating to ensure the security systems are operating. The communications shelf houses and powers the security system servers in the communications room. The communications shelf receives power directly from the electric panel. Should electrical power be disrupted, the new UPS will provide power to the communications shelf ensuring the security system servers continue to operate seamlessly.	

7. Describe the efforts and results in determining that this is the only vendor/contractor/service provider who can provide the goods, services or construction:

The sole source letter dated 02/28/25 explains that Security Resources, has achieved authorization as a Network Harbor Enterprise level System Integrator and, as of this date, they are the only system integrator that has achieved Enterprise Level authorization in the state of Hawaii. Further, as a matter of policy, all of the Network Harbor product end user accounts are registered to a specific authorized integrator for ongoing support and service account. This is to assure end users that they have an authorized dealer servicing products. The process of authorized account registration with authorized integrators is to provide both the end users and system integrators with account protection and assurance. Network Harbor will not provide products, technical assistance or any other support to unauthorized companies or individuals who may attempt to maintain or service the registered system.

8. Alternate source. Describe the other possible sources for the goods, services, or construction that were investigated but did not meet the department's needs.

No alternative sources were investigated. As stated in the sole source letter dated 02/28/25, Security Resources Pacific, Inc. has achieved authorization as a Network Harbor Enterprise level System Integrator and, as of this date, they are the only system integrator that has achieved Enterprise Level authorization in the state of Hawaii. The process of authorized account registration with authorized integrators is to provide both the end users and system integrators with account protection and assurance. Network Harbor will not provide products, technical assistance or any other support to unauthorized companies or individuals who may attempt to maintain or service the registered system. This assurance is maintained as long as a) the system integrator maintains authorized status as a Network Harbor Dealer, and b) the end user/customer has not requested severance from their registered system integrator, and c) the end user has an active ASA support agreement as registered with the end user account. Security Resources has met all of the above criteria.
