In consideration of the closing of Wahiawā District Court on Thursday, January 22, 2026 due to a shortage of sheriffs, and, under the authority of Hawai‘i Revised Statutes § 601-2, and article VI, sections 6 and 7 of the Constitution of the State of Hawai‘i,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the time for filing items due on Thursday, January 22, 2026 in Wahiawā District Court, is extended to Friday, January 23, 2026. All documents due to have been filed shall be deemed to have been timely filed if they are filed on Friday, January 23, 2026.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that hearings or trials cancelled due to the closure of the Wahiawā District Court, shall be rescheduled to the next available date with due regard for any statutory mandates.
