In consideration of the closing of the Kāne‘ohe
Courthouse (Abner Pākī Hale), District Court of the First
Circuit, due to a power outage, and, under the authority of
Hawai‘i Revised Statutes § 601-2, and article VI, sections 6
and 7 of the Constitution of the State of Hawai‘i,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the time for filing items due
at the Kāne‘ohe Courthouse (Abner Pākī Hale) on Friday,
February 13, 2026, is extended to Tuesday, February 17, 2026.
All documents due to have been filed shall be deemed to have been
timely filed if they are filed by Tuesday, February 17, 2026.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that hearings or trials cancelled due to the closure of the Kāneʻohe Courthouse (Abner Pāki Hale), shall be rescheduled to the next available date with due regard for any statutory mandates.
