AND WAHIAWĀ DISTRICT COURT

In consideration of the closing of the Kāne‘ohe District Court (Abner Pākī Hale), and Wahiawā District Court, on Monday, March 16, 2026, due to remedial work as a result of damage from weather conditions, and, under the authority of Hawai‘i Revised Statutes §§ 601-1.5 and 601-2, and article VI, sections 6 and 7 of the Constitution of the State of Hawai‘i,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the time for filing items due at the Kāne‘ohe District Court (Abner Pākī Hale) and Wahiawā District Court on Monday, March 16, 2026, is extended to

Tuesday, March 17, 2026. All documents due to have been filed shall be deemed to have been timely filed if they are filed by Tuesday, March 17, 2026.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that hearings or trials cancelled due to the closure of the Kāneʻohe District Court (Abner Pākī Hale) and Wahiawā District Court on March 16, 2026, shall be rescheduled to the next available date with due regard for any statutory mandates.
