In consideration of the closing of all of the State
Courts in the First Judicial Circuit (O'ahu) in the State of
Hawai'i, including the appellate courts, on Friday, April 10,
2026, due to inclement weather, and, under the authority of
Hawai'i Revised Statutes §§ 601-1.5 and 601-2, and article VI,
sections 6 and 7 of the Constitution of the State of Hawai'i,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the time for filing items due on Friday, April 10, 2026, in all of the State Courts in the First Judicial Circuit (O'ahu) in the State of Hawai'i, including the appellate courts, is extended to Monday, April 13, 2026. All documents due to have been filed on April 10, 2026 shall be deemed to have been filed timely if they are filed by the close of business on Monday, April 13, 2026.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that hearings or trials cancelled due to the closure of all of the State Courts in the First Judicial Circuit (O'ahu) in the State of Hawai'i, including the appellate courts, shall be rescheduled to the next available date with due regard for any statutory mandates.
