ORDER AMENDING RULE 21 OF THE HAWAI‘I CIVIL TRAFFIC RULES  
(By: Devens, C.J., McKenna, Eddins, and Ginoza, JJ., and  
Intermediate Court of Appeals Chief Judge Nakasone,  
assigned by reason of vacancy)

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Rule 21 of the Hawai‘i Civil  
Traffic Rules is amended, effective July 1, 2026, as follows  
(deleted material is bracketed and stricken; new material is  
underscored):

**Rule 21. TIME.**

**(a) Computation.** In computing any time period under these  
rules, the day of the act, event, or default from which the period of time  
begins to run shall not be included. The last day of the period so  
computed shall be included, unless it is a Saturday, Sunday, or ~~[legal]~~  
holiday. Intermediate Saturdays, Sundays, and ~~[legal]~~ holidays shall be  
included. As used in this rule, "holiday" shall mean any day designated  
as such pursuant to section 8-1 of the Hawai‘i Revised Statutes.  
Whenever an act required to be performed under these rules may be

accomplished by mail, the act shall be deemed to have been performed on the date of the postmark on the mailed article.
