ORDER AMENDING RULE 10 OF THE HAWAI‘I PROBATE RULES
(By: Devens, C.J., McKenna, Eddins, and Ginoza, JJ., and
Intermediate Court of Appeals Chief Judge Nakasone,
assigned by reason of vacancy)

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Rule 10 of the Hawai‘i
Probate Rules is amended, effective July 1, 2026, as follows
(deleted material is bracketed and stricken; new material is
underscored) :

Rule 10. COMPUTATION OF TIME.

(a) Computation. In computing any period of time prescribed or allowed by these rules, by order of court, or by any applicable statute, the day of the act, event, or default after which the designated period of time begins to run is not to be included. The last day of the period so computed is to be included, unless it is a Saturday, Sunday, or a [legal] holiday, in which event the period runs until the end of the next day which is neither a Saturday, a Sunday, nor a [legal] holiday. When the period of time prescribed or allowed is less than seven days, intermediate

Saturdays, Sundays, and holidays shall be excluded in the computation. As used in this rule, "holiday" [~~includes~~] shall mean any day designated as such pursuant to Section 8-1 of the Hawai'i Revised Statutes.
