ORDER AMENDING RULES 1 AND 53 OF THE RULES OF THE LAND COURT  
(By: Devens, C.J., McKenna, Eddins, and Ginoza, JJ., and  
Intermediate Court of Appeals Chief Judge Nakasone,  
assigned by reason of vacancy)

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Rules 1 and 53 of the Rules  
of the Land Court are amended, effective July 1, 2026, as  
follows (deleted material is bracketed and stricken; new  
material is underscored):

**Rule 1. OFFICE HOURS; FILING ORIGINAL PAPERS.**

The office of the land court shall be open from 7:45 a.m. until 4:30 p.m. every day in the year, except Saturdays, Sundays, ~~legal~~ holidays and furlough days established by law. As used in these rules, "holiday" shall mean any day designated as such pursuant to section 8-1 of the Hawai‘i Revised Statutes. Papers presented for filing shall be accepted from 8:00 a.m. until 4:00 p.m. Papers may be electronically filed in land court at all hours, except when the Judiciary Information Management System is not in operation for maintenance or other reasons.

**Rule 53. HOURS OF RECORDATION.**

The office of the assistant registrar shall be open from 7:45 a.m. until 4:30 p.m. every day of the year, except on Saturdays, Sundays and holidays [~~established by law~~], but instruments shall only be recorded between 8:00 a.m. and 3:29 p.m. Every instrument presented for recordation shall be examined for recordation by the assistant registrar in the order it is presented for that purpose and if the instrument is entitled by law to be recorded, shall be recorded:
