<p>1. Describe the goods, services or construction to be procured:</p> <p>Install a cable drop and update security equipment for the Sheriff's console at the Hilo Judiciary Complex. The job will include: cable drop from AV area to Sheriff's console, replacement of cameras and matrix switcher, and adding a joystick controller for use with the cameras.</p>

The unique features, characteristics, or capabilities of the goods, service or construction.</p> <p>The security system for Hale Kaulike, Hilo Judiciary Complex shall be serviced by an authorized representative to maintain the proper functionality of the PremiSys Access Control Management System. Security Resources Pacific, Inc. is the only company in Hawaii authorized to provide, install, service and maintain the Premisys System and the related interface software and hardware.</p> <p>Security Resources Pacific, Inc. is the Judiciary's current maintenance contractor for the security access systems and the related software and hardware at the Hilo Courthouse. They are certified to do this installation, adjustments and maintain this equipment. It is not practicable or advantageous to procure this equipment by competitive means because this equipment should integrate with the existing system and be maintained by the same vendor.</p> <p>b. How the unique features, characteristics or capabilities of the goods, service or construction are essential for the department.</p> <p>A properly functioning security system is a matter of security and safety at the Hilo Judiciary Complex. Our security system is a vital component to provide this security and safety which includes access control, video surveillance, duress, and related control systems. Due to the technical nature of the equipment and our reliance on the system to provide our courts with a safe and secure environment, it is prudent to have this system maintained by an authorized representative to ensure proper equipment performance up to manufacturer specifications.</p>	

7. Describe the efforts and results in determining that this is the only vendor/contractor/service provider who can provide the goods, services or construction:

Security Resources is the only company in Hawaii that is authorized, certified and trained to provide, install, service and maintain the existing PremiSys Security Management System, the PremiSys Access Control Management System, the PremiSys interface to the American Dynamics Video Edge System, and the related interface software and hardware. The letter also states PremiSys will not provide products, technical assistance or any other support to unauthorized companies or individuals who may attempt to maintain or service our system.

8. Alternate source. Describe the other possible sources for the goods, services, or construction that were investigated but did not meet the department's needs.

No alternate sources were investigated. Security Resources is the only company in Hawaii authorized, certified and trained to provide, install, service and maintain the existing Premisys Security Management System, the PremiSys Access Control Management System, the PremiSys Interface to the American Dynamics Video Edge system and the related interface software and hardware. Additionally, PremiSys will not provide products, technical assistance or any other support to unauthorized companies or individuals who may attempt to maintain or service our system.
