

7. Describe the efforts and results in determining that this is the only vendor/contractor/service provider who can provide the goods, services or construction:

In May 2004, an Invitation for Bid (IFB) was issued for the installation of the System at Ali'iolani Hale. Judiciary IFB Contract J04279 was awarded to the lowest Bidder, Sensormatic Hawaii (SH), with the Notice to Proceed dated July 2004. During the installation phase, SH was disqualified for deficiencies in performance and non compliance with the minimum required specifications of the Contract. In June 2005, the second lowest bidder (SRP) was retained to complete the project and has been the service provided ever since.

Ms. Karen Gutierrez, Regional Sales Manager at acre Security, provide the Judiciary a letter dated 5-8-2026. In summary, Ms. Gutierrez verifies that SRP is the only company in Hawaii that is authorized, certified, and trained to provide, install, service and maintain the existing PremiSys Security Management system, the PremiSys Access Control Management System, the PremiSys Interface to the American Dynamics Video Edge system and the related interface software and hardware.

8. Alternate source. Describe the other possible sources for the goods, services, or construction that were investigated but did not meet the department's needs.

SRP is the only company in Hawaii that is authorized, certified, and trained to provide, install, service and maintain the existing PremiSys Security Management System, the PremiSys Access Control Management System, the PremiSys Interface to the American Dynamics Video Edge System and the related interface software and hardware. PremiSys will not provide products, technical assistance or any other support to unauthorized companies or individuals who may attempt to maintain or service our system. SRP and PremiSys have invested considerable resources to develop strong support for our security needs.
