ORDER EXTENDING TIME TO FILE ITEMS DUE TO BE FILED  
IN THE CIRCUIT COURT OF THE FIRST CIRCUIT

In consideration of the closing of Ka‘ahumanu Hale located at 777 Punchbowl Street, Honolulu, Hawai‘i on Tuesday, May 5, 2026, due to a power outage, and under the authority of Hawai‘i Revised Statutes § 601-2 and article VI, sections 6 and 7 of the Constitution of the State of Hawai‘i,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the time for filing items due in the Circuit Court of the First Circuit on Tuesday, May 5, 2026, is extended to Wednesday, May 6, 2026. All documents due to have been filed on Tuesday, May 5, 2026 shall be deemed to have been timely filed if they are filed by Wednesday May 6, 2026.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that hearings or trials cancelled due to the closure of Ka'ahumanu Hale shall be rescheduled to the next available date with due regard for any statutory mandates.
