In consideration of the closing of the District Court of the First Circuit, ‘Ewa-Pearl City Division, located at 870 Fourth Street, Pearl City, Hawai‘i on Friday, May 15, 2026, due to a power outage, and under the authority of Hawai‘i Revised Statutes § 601-2 and article VI, sections 6 and 7 of the Constitution of the State of Hawai‘i,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the time for filing items due in the District Court of the First Circuit, ‘Ewa-Pearl City Division on Friday, May 15, 2026, is extended to Monday, May 18, 2026. All documents due to have been filed on Friday, May 15,

2026 shall be deemed to have been timely filed if they are filed by Monday May 18, 2026.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that hearings or trials cancelled due to the closure of the District Court of the First Circuit, 'Ewa-Pearl City Division shall be rescheduled to the next available date with due regard for any statutory mandates.
