ORDER DISMISSING APPEAL

(1) The statement of jurisdiction and opening brief were due on or before January 2, 2026, and April 20, 2026, respectively;

(2) Self-represented Defendant-Appellant Colleen Lasham (**Lasham**) failed to file either document or request an additional extension of time;

(3) On June 16, 2026, the appellate clerk entered a default notice informing Lasham that the time for filing the statement of jurisdiction and opening brief had expired, the matter would be called to the court's attention on June 26, 2026, for appropriate action, which could include dismissal of the appeal, under Hawai'i Rules of Appellate Procedure Rules 12.1(e) and 30, and Lasham could request relief from default by motion; and

(4) Lasham has not taken any further action in this appeal.
