<p>1. Describe the goods, services or construction to be procured: One (1) year maintenance service agreement for the video surveillance, access control, duress, and keyboard alert systems at Hoapili Hale.</p>

<p>6. Describe in detail the following:</p> <p>a. The unique features, characteristics, or capabilities of the goods, service or construction. Security Resources Pacific (SRP), Inc., is the original installer, has the knowledge and technical expertise necessary to maintain the systems, and has consistently performed satisfactory service and repair work in the past. The current video surveillance, access control, and duress systems are integrated via nodes that were provided at the time of installation of each system. Each node communicates to the other nodes which monitor system statuses, display videos, annunciate duress alarms, and provide real time information of the overall site. These nodes as well as each system are only maintainable and serviceable by SRP. Maintenance or service provided by others may degrade the functionality of each system which may result in loss of video, duress alarm annunciation or control of the access system. SRP currently maintains the Judiciary access control database which integrates the duress alarms and video monitoring from other circuits.</p> <p>b. How the unique features, characteristics or capabilities of the goods, service or construction are essential for the department. Maintenance of the various security systems is essential to court security at Hoapili Hale. SRP is the only authorized company in Hawai'i that is properly certified and suitably trained to provide, install, service and maintain the existing PremiSys Security Management system, the PremySys Access Control Management System, the PremiSys Interface to the American Dynamics Video Edge system and the related interface software and hardware. PremiSys will not provide products, technical assistance or any other support to unauthorized companies or individuals who may attempt to maintain or service our system.</p>	

7. Describe the efforts and results in determining that this is the only vendor/contractor/service provider who can provide the goods, services or construction:

SRP is the only authorized company in Hawai'i that is properly certified and suitably trained to service and maintain the software for the PremiSys Security Management system, PremiSys Access Control Management system, the PremiSys Interface to the American Dynamics Video Edge system and related interface software and hardware. PremiSys will not provide products, technical assistance or any other support to unauthorized companies or individuals who may attempt to maintain or service our system.

8. Alternate source. Describe the other possible sources for the goods, services, or construction that were investigated but did not meet the department's needs.

SRP is the only vendor in Hawaii authorized to provide the maintenance for these security systems. Additionally, PremiSys will not provide products, technical assistance or any other support to unauthorized companies or individuals who may attempt to maintain or service our system.
