a. The unique features, characteristics, or capabilities of the goods, service or construction.

Hilo Judiciary Complex uses Automated Logic Web CTRL products for its environmental controls. Island Controls Inc. installed all the original equipment for Hilo Judiciary Complex and they solely represent the Automated Logic Web CTRL equipment and maintenance in the State of Hawaii. ALC's reputation is predicated upon providing building automation systems which are intuitively designed, feature rich, extremely powerful, and provide many years of reliable operation. Island Controls' local expertise and resources, combined with the company's access to Island Controls' engineering resources and support reassures that the Judiciary will continue to have access to their expertise and support. We require our maintenance contractor to be authorized by our controls manufacturer, Automated Logic (ALC). For reasons of safety, health, energy efficiency, it is prudent to avoid consequent uncertainties and complications of introducing vendors not authorized the by our equipment manufacturer.

b. How the unique features, characteristics or capabilities of the goods, service or construction are essential for the department.

The Automated Logic Web CTRL system at Hilo Judiciary Complex regulates the building's ventilation and air conditioning systems. A proper environment is important to the health and comfort of people in the courthouse, workers, and public alike, and to the integrity and longevity of records and equipment inside the courthouse. Island Controls, Inc. is responsible for all aspects of our product including design, engineering, programming, installation, start-up, ALC hardware/software sales, warranty support of ALC systems and factory training.

7. Describe the efforts and results in determining that this is the only vendor/contractor/service provider who can provide the goods, services or construction:

The system installed at Hilo Judiciary Complex is an Automated Logic – WebCTRL System. Island Controls, Inc. is the exclusive Authorized Dealer for the State of Hawaii since 1998. Automated Logic (ALC) products and services are solely represented in the State of Hawaii by Island Controls. They are responsible for all aspects of ALC products including design, engineering, programming, installation, start-up and warranty. This includes ALC hardware/software sales, warranty support of ALC systems and factory training. Island Controls has been an authorized dealer of ALC products and there are no other factory authorized vendors in Hawaii.

Automated Logic (ALC) products and services are solely represented in the State of Hawaii by Island Controls, Inc. since 1998. They are responsible for all aspects of our product including design, engineering, programming, installation, start-up and warranty. This includes ALC hardware/software sales, warranty support of ALC systems and factory training. Other than Island Controls, Inc., Automated Logic (ALC) has no factory authorized representatives in the state of Hawaii, as such no other sources would meet the department needs.
