<p>1. Describe the goods, services or construction to be procured: One-year service agreement for maintenance and support of the Wireless Proximity Access Identification Card System serving Ali'iōlani Hale and the Kapuaiwa Building.</p>

6. Describe in detail the following:

a. The unique features, characteristics, or capabilities of the goods, service or construction.

The Wireless Proximity Access Identification Card System was installed at Ali'iōlani Hale in 2005 and expanded to the Kapuaiwa Building in 2006. Security Resources Pacific (SRP) has provided maintenance and support for the System since 2006 and is the only company in Hawaii authorized, certified, and trained to service and maintain the System's proprietary software. SRP has the specialized knowledge and technical expertise required to maintain the System's continued reliable operation.

b. How the unique features, characteristics or capabilities of the goods, service or construction are essential for the department.

The System is an essential component of the Judiciary's courthouse security infrastructure and provides access control for Ali'iōlani Hale and the Kapuaiwa Building. The System is integrated with other security systems, including the Courthouse Security Camera Surveillance and Recording System, Keyboard Alert System, Judiciary Gunshot Detection Program, and Public Address System. Continued maintenance and support are necessary to ensure system compatibility, reliability, and uninterrupted security operations.

7. Describe the efforts and results in determining that this is the only vendor/contractor/service provider who can provide the goods, services or construction:

The Judiciary determined that SRP is the only qualified provider based on manufacturer authorization and certification. A letter dated March 19, 2025, from Acre Security confirms that SRP is the only company in Hawaii authorized, certified, and trained to provide, install, service, and maintain the existing PremiSys Security Management System, PremiSys Access Control Management System, the PremiSys interface to the American Dynamics VideoEdge system, and related software and hardware. SRP has maintained the Judiciary's system since the original installation and possesses the specialized expertise required to support the existing System.

8. Alternate source. Describe the other possible sources for the goods, services, or construction that were investigated but did not meet the department's needs.

Other potential service providers were considered; however, no alternate source can meet the Judiciary's requirements. SRP is the only company in Hawaii authorized, certified, and trained by the manufacturer to provide service and maintenance for the existing PremiSys Security Management System, PremiSys Access Control Management System, related interfaces, software, and hardware. The manufacturer does not provide technical support, products, or assistance to unauthorized vendors or individuals. Therefore, other vendors are unable to provide the required maintenance and support services.
