Request approval to purchase a Victor Performance PC Workstation with Monitor to access the Department of Law Enforcement (DLE) cameras on Judiciary properties.

This Victor Performance PC Workstation will enable us to view, record and save video footage from the new DLE cameras installed at Circuit Court, Lot R, District Court, Ali'iōlani Hale and the Kapuāiwa Building.

6. Describe in detail the following:

a. The unique features, characteristics, or capabilities of the goods, service or construction.

The Department of Law Enforcement camera system installed at the Judiciary locations listed above have a service and maintenance agreement with Security Resources Pac. Inc. Any other vendor to install or service this system will void the maintenance agreement DLE has with Security Resources Pac. Inc. To maintain the proper functionality of the Victor Performance PC Workstation, Security Resources Pac. Inc. will periodically service the system. Their system also integrates all of the security and camera systems within the Circuit. The First Circuit has an integrated security management and monitoring system in all of its courthouses. The system includes: the PremiSys Security Management system, PremiSys Access Control Management system, and the American Dynamics Video Edge Victor management system. The Judiciary for these reasons needs an installer that is supported by PremiSys in the event there is a system problem that requires technical assistance or engineering and possesses the expertise required to install and maintain our existing systems.



b. How the unique features, characteristics or capabilities of the goods, service or construction are essential for the department.

The only vendor in Hawaii that can provide all necessary services across our system is Security Resources. They are the only company in Hawaii that is authorized, certified, and trained to provide, install, service and maintain the existing PremiSys Security Management system, the PremiSys Access Control Management System, the PremiSys Interface to the American Dynamics Video Edge system and the related interface software and hardware.

7. Describe the efforts and results in determining that this is the only vendor/contractor/service provider who can provide the goods, services or construction:

We made a request to the company that has the propriety rights to PremiSys systems as described above to ask what companies were authorized and trained to service, maintain and install the system in Hawaii. Security Resources Pacific, Inc. is the only company in Hawaii that is authorized, certified, and trained to provide, install, service and maintain the existing PremiSys Security Management system, the PremiSys Access Control Management System, the PremiSys Interface to the American Dynamics Video Edge system and the related interface software and hardware. Security Resources Pacific, Inc. will not provide products, technical assistance or any other support to unauthorized companies or individuals who may attempt to maintain or service this system.

Security Resources is the only company in Hawaii that is authorized, certified, and trained to provide, install, service and maintain the existing PremiSys Security Management system, the PremiSys Access Control Management System, the PremiSys Interface to the American Dynamics Video Edge system and the related interface software and hardware.
