OR TO CONDUCT HEARINGS REQUIRED TO BE HELD ON MONDAY,
AUGUST 17, 2026 IN ALL OF THE COURTS IN THE STATE OF HAWAI‘I

In consideration of the closing of all Courts in the State of Hawai‘i, including courts of the First, Second, Third, and Fifth Judicial Circuits and the appellate courts, on Monday, August 17, 2026, due to the impact of Hurricane Lala, and under the authority of Hawai‘i Revised Statutes § 601-2 and article VI, Sections 6 and 7 of the Constitution of the State of Hawai‘i,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the time for filing items due on Monday, August 17, 2026, in any of the Courts of the State of Hawai'i, including the First, Second, Third, and Fifth Judicial Circuits and the appellate courts, is extended to Tuesday, August 18, 2026. All documents due to have been filed shall be deemed to have been filed timely if they are filed by the close of business on Tuesday, August 18, 2026.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that hearings or trials cancelled due to the closure of the Courts of the State of Hawai'i on Monday, August 17, 2026, shall be rescheduled to the next available date with due regard for any statutory mandates.
