OR TO CONDUCT HEARINGS REQUIRED TO BE HELD ON
TUESDAY, SEPTEMBER 8, 2026 IN THE FIRST JUDICIAL CIRCUIT

In consideration of the closing of all of the State
Courts in the First Judicial Circuit, Island of O'ahu, and the
Appellate Courts, on Tuesday, September 8, 2026, due to the
effects of Hurricane Lowell, and under the authority of Hawai'i
Revised Statutes §§ 601-1.5 and 601-2, and article VI, sections
6 and 7 of the Constitution of the State of Hawai'i,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the time for filing documents due to have been filed in the State Circuit, District, and District Family Courts in the First Judicial Circuit, Island of O'ahu, and the Appellate Courts, on Tuesday, September 8, 2026, is extended to Wednesday, September 9, 2026. All documents due to have been filed in the First Judicial Circuit Island of O'ahu, and the Appellate Courts, on Tuesday, September 8, 2026, shall be deemed to have been timely filed if they are filed by the end of the day on Wednesday, September 9, 2026.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that hearings or trials cancelled due to the closure of the courts in the First Judicial Circuit, Island of O'ahu, and the Appellate Courts, on Tuesday, September 8, 2026, shall be rescheduled to the next available date with due regard for any statutory mandates.
