ORDER EXTENDING TIME TO FILE ITEMS DUE TO BE FILED
OR TO CONDUCT HEARINGS REQUIRED TO BE HELD ON
MONDAY, SEPTEMBER 14, 2026, AT KAUIKEAOULI HALE

In consideration of the closure of the District Court
of the First Circuit, Honolulu Division (Kauikeaouli Hale),
located at 1111 Alakea Street, on Monday, September 14, 2026,
due to the loss of water and air conditioning in the building,
and under the authority of Hawai'i Revised Statutes §601-2, and
article VI, sections 6 and 7 of the Constitution of the State of
Hawai'i,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the time for filing documents due to have been filed at Kauikeaouli Hale, on Monday, September 14, 2026, is extended to Tuesday, September 15, 2026. All documents due to have been filed at Kauikeaouli Hale on Monday, September 14, 2026, shall be deemed to have been filed timely if they are filed by the end of the day on Tuesday, September 15, 2026.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that matters scheduled to be heard on Monday, September 14, 2026, at Kauikeaouli Hale, will be heard as follows:

- 1) All District Court matters scheduled in Courtroom 7C and all preliminary hearings will be heard at the District Court, Kāneʻohe Division, Abner Pākī Hale, located at 45-939 Poʻokela Street.
- 2) All Family Court criminal cases scheduled to be heard on the 8th floor will be heard in Courtroom 5 on the 3rd floor of the First Circuit Court, Kaʻahumanu Hale, located at 777 Punchbowl Street in Honolulu.
- 3) All matters scheduled to be heard in Courtrooms 4A, 4B, 7A, 7B, 10A, 10B, 10C, and 10D will be

rescheduled to the next available date with due regard for any statutory mandates.
