furtherance of the implementation of effective caseflow
management practices in the First Circuit Court, State of
Hawaii, and in the interests of the orderly administration of
justice in the State of Hawaii,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the implementation of an
Individual Trial Calendar System is authorized for civil cases in
the First Circuit Court, commencing February 14, 2000.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that First Circuit Judges Karen L.
Blondin, Gary W. B. Chang, Eden B. Hifo, Colleen Hirai, Sabrina
McKenna, and Gail Nakatani shall establish and maintain
individual civil trial calendars until further order of the
court. First Circuit Judge Kevin S. C. Chang shall continue as
Administrative Judge of the Civil Division.
