ORDER DESIGNATING CIRCUIT JUDGES OF THE FIRST JUDICIAL CIRCUIT OF THE STATE OF HAWAI'I TO ACT AS CIRCUIT FAMILY JUDGES

Pursuant to Hawai'i Revised Statutes § 571-4, I, RONALD T. Y. MOON, Chief Justice of the Supreme Court of the State of Hawai'i, do hereby designate the several circuit judges and any acting circuit judge of the Circuit Court of the First Judicial Circuit to act as circuit family judges, on an as needed basis, to hear such family court matters as shall be assigned to them by the Senior Family Judge of First Circuit, who shall coordinate such assignments with the appropriate Administrative Judge of the First Circuit Court; provided that all acting circuit family judges shall also hear such circuit court matters as may be assigned to them by their respective administrative judge. This designation shall be effective upon the filing of this order and shall remain in effect until otherwise ordered.

This designation shall also apply to any judge who may hereinafter be appointed and qualified as a circuit judge of the First Judicial Circuit and shall be effective immediately upon his or her signing of the oath of office.
